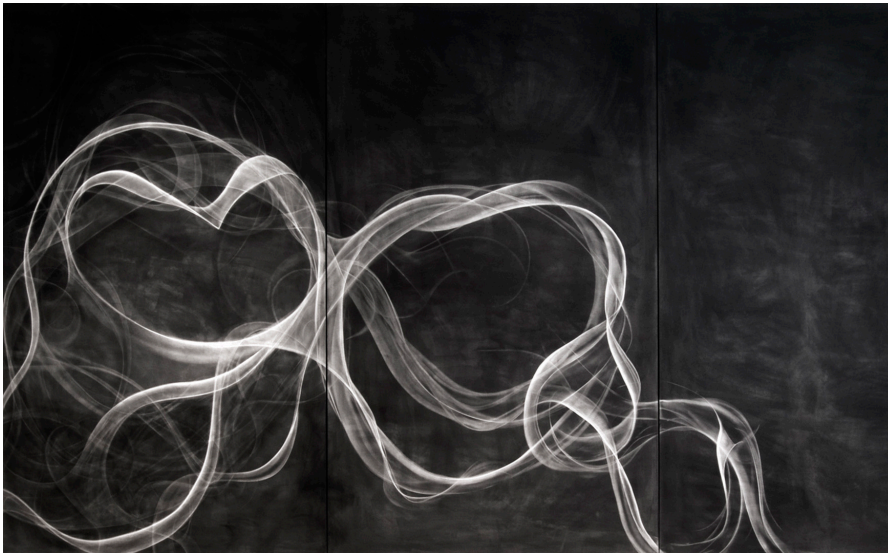


21st CENTURY ART

Start your journey on the third floor!

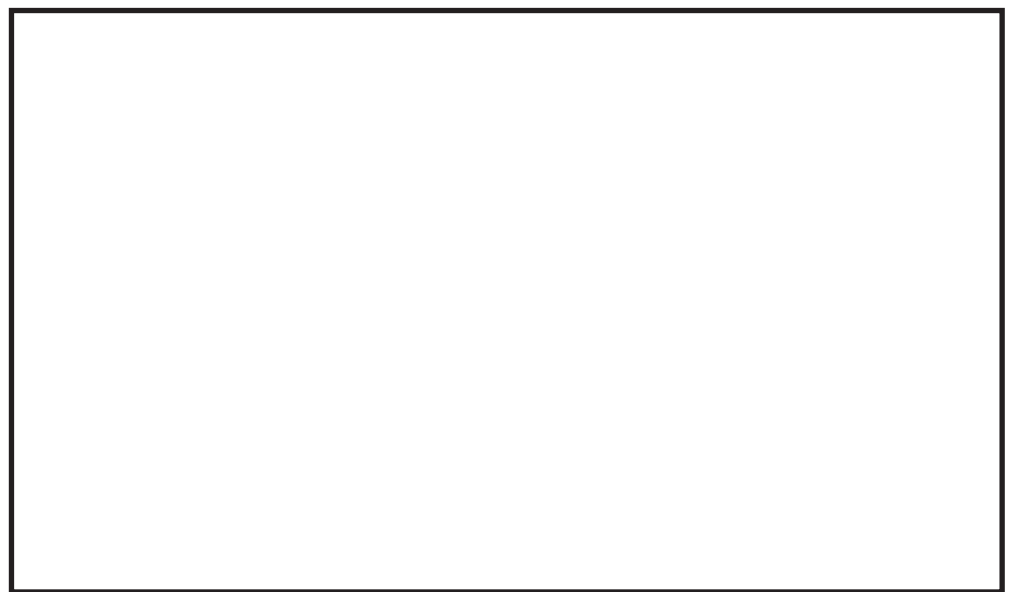
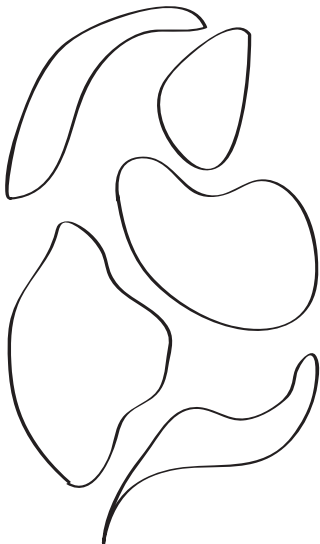
Can you find Mark Sheinkman's *Concourse*??

Do you like this piece of art? Why or why not?

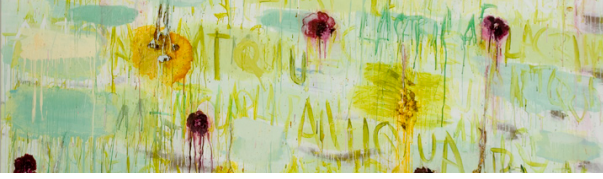
Use the shapes below to create your own *Concourse*-style drawing!
